NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 9th May, 2011

G.S.R. 369(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution and in supersession of the Cochin Export Processing Zone Cochin (Group 'C' and 'D' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2000 insofar as they relate to the posts of Peon, Duplicating Operator and Security Guard, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Peon, Duplicating Operator and Security Guard in Cochin Special Economic Zone, Cochin, under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called Cochin Special Economic Zones, Cochin (Multi Tasking Staff) Recruitment Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay/Scale of Pay.—The number of said posts, their classification and pay band, grade pay/scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the pay band grade pay Schedule, annexed to these rules.

3. Method of Recruitment, Age-limit, Qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to Relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
