

G.S.R__ . __ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Cochin Special Economic Zone, Kochi - Assistant Development Commissioner, Recruitment Rules, 2003 namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Cochin Special Economic Zone, Kochi Assistant Development Commissioner, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2007.
2. In Cochin Special Economic Zone, Kochi - Assistant Development Commissioner, Recruitment Rules, 2000, in the schedule in column 11, for the existing heading, the following heading shall be substituted namely:-

"Method of recruitment. Whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation or absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods."

G.S.R. 609(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in partial supersession of the Cochin Export Processing Zone, Cochin (Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1997 published vide G.S.R. No. 617 (E) dated 24.10.1997, in so far as it relates to the posts of Assistant Development Commissioner and Section Officer (Accounts), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Development Commissioner and Section Officer (Accounts) in Cochin Special Economic Zone, Kochi, under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, namely:

2. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called as Cochin Special Economic Zone, Kochi - Assistant Development Commissioner and Section Officer (Accounts) Recruitment Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.** - The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule, annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, and other matter relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(c) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any persons,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion:

Assistant in the pay scale of Rs. 5000-8000 with six years of regular service in the grade and (The departmental Office Superintendent in the pay scale of Rs.5500-9000 with three years' regular service will also be considered alongwith the Assistant in the pay scale of Rs. 5000-8000).

Note:

Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion. they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation:

Officers under the Central Government:

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
- (ii) with three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 5500-9000 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; or
- (iii) with six years' regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 5000-8000 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing two years experience in the field of Industrial development or foreign trade.

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
