New Delhi, the 24th October, 1997

G.S.R. 617 (E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Cochin Export Processing Zone, Cochin (Group 'A' & 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1987 in so far as they relate to the posts of Development Commissioner, Deputy Development Commissioner, Administrative Officer, Assistant Development Commissioner, Estate Manager, Executive Assistant, Section Officer (Accounts), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following Recruitment Rules relating to the method of recruitment to certain Group 'A' & 'B' posts in the Cochin Export Processing Zone, Cochin, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement—(1) These rules may be called the Cochin Export Processing Zone, Cochin (Group 'A' & 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1986.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay—The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matter relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

5. Disqualifications—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts :

Provided that the Central Govt. may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax—Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary and expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, and the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

III. The Departmental Joint Development Commissioner with 5 years' regular service in the grade will also be considered along with outsiders and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

Note :

The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/ Department of the Central Government shall not exceed five years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).

II. The Departmental Assistant Development Commissioner with 8 years' regular service in the grade will also be considered along with outsiders and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

Note :

The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organisation/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications).
